WHAT ARE SPECIAL AREAS?

Cedar Bluff has a 9-day Special Area rotation. In that rotation, they will visit Music (2x), Art (2x), Library (2x), STEM (1x), and Physical Education (2x). A calendar is sent home every month by your child's classroom teacher with the rotation schedule. Please be sure your child is aware of the rotation schedule and is dressed appropriately for the class they have on any given day.

In the case of a school cancellation due to inclement weather or illness, we will not skip days in the rotation. So, if it is Day 3 and school is cancelled, it will be Day 3 when we return.

BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

In order to make these visits enjoyable, educational, and engaging for all our students, we ask that they follow the following behavior expectations.

- Follow directions the first time you are asked.
- Participate in all activities.
- Keep hands and feet to yourself.
- Sit safely in your spot.
- Take care of our equipment, materials, instruments and technology.
- Be respectful to classmates and teachers.

If for any reason a child does not follow one of these expectations, a warning will be given. After that warning, if the behavior continues, they will earn a behavior mark and a lower behavior grade for that nine weeks. At teacher's discretion, severe misbehavior or disrespect may result in alternative or accelerated consequences.
