LONG + LIVE + MATH

- Follow the link in bold above to the KCS Online Textbook Resources webpage and click on the "Carnegie Learning" link.
- The first time, a student will select "Set Password" on the login page. Then enter their school name and the username provided by their teacher. (After that, they will log in using the login box on the right-hand side of the screen.)
- On the homescreen, your student's classes should be listed, Click "Launch eText" on any of the class boxes to view resources.
