



## DEO STEERING COMMITTEE MEETING

CO-CHAIRS TOMMA BATTLE AND ROSA MAR

Oct. 6, 2020

- Superintendent Bob Thomas opened the meeting and welcomed Daniel Watson, who is the Committee’s new Board of Education representative. Co-chair Tomma Battle welcomed Committee members.
  
- Executive Director of Teaching and Learning Shannon Jackson introduced a presentation about the YouScience aptitude program, which helps middle and high school students identify possible career choices, and helps the district design relevant programming.
  
- Director of Career and Technical Education Keith Wilson and College and Career Specialist Christy Seals gave an overview of the program. South-Doyle Middle School principal Anthony Norris, assistant principal Katye Clemmons and 8th-grade counselor Maleka Tate discussed the program’s implementation at their school.
  
- Assistant Superintendent and Chief Academic Officer Jon Rysewyk gave an update on the virtual learning program, including in-person and virtual enrollment by grade band and BOE District. (Numbers as of Sept. 4, 2020.)
